



Founders OT Worship Course Supply List:

Lesson: Project - Supplies

- 1: Prayer Wall: supplies will vary depending on what your learners choose to do; a fantastic option is ribbon, colored clothespins, tacks or command hooks, and index cards. You can also decorate a whiteboard or bulletin board - or frame a Bible verse and simply add sticky notes on the wall as you go.
- 2: Paper, stickers and [letter stickers](#)
- 3: Tent Tabernacle: Blankets and chairs for an indoor tent or a tent that you can pitch outside OR Build a Tabernacle: Legos/Building Blocks or the Computer Game [Minecraft](#)
- 4: High Priest Dress Up: An oversized shirt, colorful vest or sleeveless top, belt or sash, a colorful piece of fabric, 12 colorful stones or beads, safety pins, fabric glue or a needle and thread, a pillowcase and colored cardboard or golden headband that says Holiness to the LORD.
- 5: Whole Wheat Flour hard white or spelt, water, olive oil and salt. An oven is needed for this project.
- 6: Statue
- 7: Sukkah: Lattice panels, two by fours, and hemp rope. You can decorate your Sukkah with leaves, pine boughs, and fall harvest items OR Smaller Sukkah: popsicle sticks, hot glue, twine, bits of cloth and fake fall leaves
- 8: Clean, empty glass jars, [gold glitter](#), clear glue, [1" flat artist's brush](#), a spoon and a pillar or flameless candle
- 11: A snack or picnic lunch to share together
- 12: 25 wads of paper and masking tape
- 14: Sticks, paper, cardboard, branches, matches, a container and a small shovel.
- 15: One white rock and black rock (any rocks would do so long as they are identical in size and shape) about the same size and a [pouch](#) to put them in.
DIY Pouch supplies: Fabric, ribbon or cord, a scissors, a ruler and a pencil
- 18: Gauze wrap or extra rags.
- 19: Items to make baskets for common illnesses including things like kleenex, cough drops, cough medicine, tea, etc.
- 20: Small action figures or lego people
- 21: [Brach's Cinnamon Imperials](#) (or Red Hots), [White Sprinkles](#) and Corn Syrup
- 26: 3 toilet paper tubes per horn. (Paper towel tubes will work, but you will need to cut them down to approx. toilet paper tube length), a horn mouthpiece from a party horn, masking tape, tape and chenille sticks.
- 27: Milk, sugar, and vanilla in a sandwich bag. Place that bag inside a larger bag that's filled with ice and rock salt (or [ice cream salt](#))
- 28: Tithe Bank: Template pages (FREE from - <https://truewaykids.com/king-joash/>), color crayons, or colored pencils, scissors, and glue. Toss the Tithe: 10 coins, buckets
- 30: Legos
- 32: Milk or juice carton, round stick or pencil a piece of cardboard, a piece of wire, a craft knife (with adult supervision), scissors, thick thread, glue and a plastic toothpaste or bottle cap
- 34: Paper, colored pencils, crayons, or paint and paint brushes.
- 35: A rock, paint and paint brushes or markers.
- 36: Pictures of family members for a family tree and/or a [printed template of a tree](#)
- 38: Rocks of various sizes
- 40: Legos
- 46: [King Solomon Asks for Wisdom Coloring Page](#) and crayons, markers or colored pencils
- 47: Paper, colored pencils, markers or crayons and any other supplies for the students' creation!



- 48: [Air Dry Clay](#), rolling pin, glass bowls, [acrylic craft paint](#), paintbrush and fine sandpaper
- 52: a Bible, masking tape, petroleum jelly, cotton balls, a table and paper plates
- 54: [Print Books of the Bible Bookmark](#), crayons.
- 55: Armor of God: Art supplies of choice, such as colored pencils, markers, or paints
- Sword of the Spirit Craft: 2 popsicle sticks, 1 orthodontic rubber band (optional), glue, [shiny jewels/stickers](#) from the craft section and a small piece of foil
- 56: Props for your skit
- 59: 10-20 dolls, action figures, Lego people, or other small figures
- 62: Colored pencils, printed [2 Chronicles 29](#) chapter and/or your Bible for marking
- 67: One pencil with an attached eraser per child, one thumbtack per child, one copy of the spinner page, printed double sided, per child, scissors, glue, a hole punch (optional), crayons, markers, or colored pencils, if desired
- 68: A flat rock, acrylic paints, paintbrush
- 72: Trust in the LORD: A blindfold and some obstacles (chairs, cushions, etc) to navigate around OR Tasting God's Goodness: ingredients needed will depend on what your learner chooses (suggested Angel Food cake: sugar, vanilla, egg whites, almond extract, salt, cream of tartar, cake flour, cake pan, oven)
- 73: Toothpaste, a spoon and a paper plate
- 74: [origami paper](#) (usually 15x15 cm)
- 76: Cardstock (for [printing](#) off the chapter), colored pencils, crayons, water colors, paint brushes or any other supplies as students create.
- 77: [Liquid Watercolors](#), [a palette](#), paper towels, 5x7 watercolor paper, brushes, [white Gouache](#), [artist's tape](#) (masking tape or painters tape work too), water jars, an old toothbrush
- 78: Paper, a marker and something to color with...markers, crayons, colored pencils or even paint.
- 79: Supplies will vary. Paper, color pencils, markers, crayons, watercolor paints, paint brushes, etc.
- 80: Fresh green leaves of various shapes and sizes from a plant, paper, a paper towel, and a hammer.
- 82: Watercolor paper 5x7 (preferably 100% cotton!), watercolor paints (yellow, orange, pink, purple, black), watercolor round brushes, masking tape (for taping down your watercolor paper), water jars a paper towel, white gel pen, [white Gouache](#) and a blow dryer
- 83: Stiff paper plates (we used Chinett lunch plates), [curling ribbon](#)— any color, [silver jingle bells](#), marker pens, stickers, scissors, [fishing line](#), hot glue gun (parental supervision required), hole punch
- 84: [Blank cards](#), embellishments for decorating cards and/or water colors, paint brushes, markers, crayons, colored pencils
- 85: hard boiled eggs, lentils, bread/bagels
- 86: [Sea glass](#), or shattered/broken glass (you can purchase glassware in different colors at a thrift store - don't break anything precious!), [modge podge](#) or other strong, clear glue, a canvas, large flat tile, or other background for your art, gloves to protect your hands.
- 87: 66 Styrofoam cups with all the books of the Bible written out on them. This can be done ahead of time.
- 88: A clear plastic bin, an ice cube tray and food coloring (blue and red)
- 90: a Bible, a beach towel and 10 inflated balloons
- 91: Legos, and/or post-it notes, and a marker.
- 92: Paper, markers, colored pencils, crayons, or watercolor/brushes OR legos of blocks for building
- 99: Two large poster boards, 12 Wooden Clothespins, 36 Flat headed Tacks, Hot Glue Gun and Glue (with adult supervision), Balloons, a Sharpie Marker and Bean Bags. Many of these supplies can be gotten at a thrift store.
- 102: [alphabet pasta](#), carrots, onion, & celery are added to broth along with a can of tomatoes and potatoes. For a shortcut, you can use frozen veggies, garlic, Italian seasoning, salt, & pepper
- 104: Paper, marker and colored pencils, watercolors and brushes or crayons.
- 105: Wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet - you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape



- 106: Two Styrofoam houses, scoop of sand, piece of ceramic tile, two glass cake pans, two glass jars (one filled with water and one filled with acetone / 18-20 oz. each), spray bottle with water (rain)
- 109: Legos are an optional add-on for today's project
- 111: Write captions and verses on the paper plate to celebrate God's creation becoming creative (see website for ideas), molded play-doh, twisted pipe cleaners, ribbon design, crosses, stickers, glitter, as desired, string or pipe cleaner, if desired.
- 113: Wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet - you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape
- 115: Choose [a recipe](#) or go with [Healthy Fried Rice](#) (cooked brown rice, olive oil, asparagus, bell pepper, scallions, garlic, ginger, liquid aminos, rice vinegar, sesame oil, hot sauce, skillet, knife and cutting board, stove top)
- 116: Legos or paper, markers, crayons or colored pencils
- 117: Supplies for a campfire include wood, kindling, matches, and a safe spot for a fire; chairs; instruments if you want to do worship with music, and s'mores ingredients and sticks (optional but fun)
- 118: Blank paper, markers and/or crayons, a sheet of construction paper, [template](#) of humble pie printed (p. 9 of the pdf), markers or crayons, scissors and glue stick.
- 119: Butcher block paper, markers, color crayons, colored pencils and any other embellishments students need to create the writing on the wall.
- 120: One piece of construction paper (yellow), 1 Toilet paper roll, 1 foam ball (slightly larger than the opening in a toilet paper roll), 1 scrap of yellow tissue paper, 5 pipe cleaners (yellow, orange, brown and/or orange or comparable colors), 2 medium googly eyes and 5 yellow pom poms (2 medium, 2 small, and 1 very small)
- 122: Paper, a marker and something to color with.
- 124: Outdoor or large open space, cones or chairs to weave around, jump rope, balls, pool noodles scrap lumber... exact items needed will vary
- 126: Paper, markers, [watercolors](#), [paint brushes](#), colored pencils, [craypas](#) or any other media supplies needed.
- 130: Ingredients and supplies to host some friends for a meal; specific items needed will vary. Choose a treat or meal that your guests will love!
- 131: A beanbag or a beachball
- 132: Chairs and music!
- 133: Wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet - you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape
- 134: White t-shirt, fabric paint
- 136: Craft yarn – red, green, or yellow (the cheap yarn will do, \$2 a skein), pipe cleaners (or chenille stems) – brown and green and a piece of cardboard – 2 in x 5 in
- 139: 1/2 cup Honey, 3/4 cup peanut butter and 3 cups Cheerios. You will need a stove top or hotplate for this project.
- 140: Pomegranate Art: Paper, marker, pencil, crayons AND/OR Fruit Salad: sugar, fresh mint, strawberries, halved or quartered if large, honeydew melon, red grapes, green grapes, 4 kiwis, and pomegranate seeds
- 142: Heart cookie cutter (or heart stencil), cardboard, a scissors, yarn and a pen
- 143: A medicine ball (really any kick ball or basketball-sized object will do), floor or yoga mat (optional)
- 144: Glass mason jars of any size, acrylic paint in any color, paintbrush, black vinyl or black paint, pea gravel, potting soil, and [a plant](#)
