

Thinkers Bible OT Worship Course Supply List:

<u>Lesson: Project - Supplies</u>

- 1: *Prayer Wall* supplies will vary depending on what your learners choose to do; a fantastic option is ribbon, colored clothespins, tacks or command hooks, and index cards. You can also decorate a whiteboard or bulletin board or frame a Bible verse and simply add sticky notes on the wall as you go.
- 3: *Tabernacle* a copy of this <u>printable template</u> (ideally on cardstock) or materials like clay, popsicle sticks, paper, fabric, and more
- 4: Aaron's Garments art supplies of your choice, such as colored pencils, markers, crayons or paint as well as paper
- 6: Golden Calf paper or golden calf coloring page, lighter or matches, safe place to burn the paper, adult supervision
- 7: *Sukkah* Grab some lattice panels, two by fours, and hemp rope. You can decorate your Sukkah with leaves, pine boughs, and fall harvest items.
- 10: *Unleavened bread* flour, olive oil, salt, flour, mixing bowl, spoon, oven and cookie sheet (if baking) or stovetop and pan (if frying)
- 11: <u>Fat Experiment</u> flour, salt, sugar, yeast, butter, heavy cream, light cream, non-fat light cream, non-fat milk, oven or bread machine, bread pans, tape measure, stop watch, electric hand mixer
- 11: OR *Tallow Balm* tallow (ideally grass-fed), jojoba oil, beeswax, essential oils, pan or double boiler, stovetop, container to store your balm
- 15: *Barbeque* grill or other means of roasting your meat, beef or lamb, chicken, and some items with grain (bread or tortilla).
- 15: OR Anointing Oil myrrh, cinnamon, calamus, and cassia essential oils, olive oil, bottle to mix the oils in
- 26: Feasts Poster paper or cardstock, art supplies of choice (colored pencils, paints, markers, etc.)
- 27: Golden Lampstand clay, pipe cleaners, tin foil, or other material, gold or yellow paint
- 34: Bible Memory Hopscotch chalk and a sidewalk or driveway, or tape if indoors
- 35: Bookmark cardstock or thin light-colored cardboard, art supplies of choice, yarn and a hole punch
- 38: Model of the Ark yellow or gold clay, popsicle sticks and/or skewers, cardboard base to build on
- 38: OR Paper Ark a copy of this print out, scissors, glue
- 40: *Keywords* a copy of <u>1 Chronicles 17</u> if you don't want to highlight in your Bible, highlights or colored pencils
- 44: *Keywords* a copy of <u>1 Chronicles 28</u> if you don't want to highlight in your Bible, highlights or colored pencils
- 48: *Temple Model -* clay, Play-doh, or other supplies (popsicle sticks, skewers, cardboard, glue...) for a temple model. Use what you have on hand!
- 51: Domino Train Memory Verse dominos, paper, tape
- 52: Keyword Study copy of 2 Chronicles 9 (or mark in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters
- 55: Armor of God art supplies of choice, such as colored pencils, markers, or paints
- 56: Keywords a printed copy of 2 Chronicles 17 (or mark in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters
- 59: Campaign Poster paper and art supplies, such as colored pencils, markers, or crayons
- 59: OR Crowning Joash 10-20 dolls, action figures, Lego people, or other small figures
- 60: Keywords a copy of 2 Chronicles 26 (or mark in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters, and/or colored



pencils

- 64: *Keywords* a copy of <u>2 Chronicles 33</u> (or mark in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters, and/or colored pencils
- 67: Meditate on Psalm 1 index cards or cardstock, art supplies of choice (colored pencils, markers, etc.)
- 72: *Keyword Study* a copy of the Psalm of your learner's choice (or mark in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters
- 72: OR *Tasting God's Goodness* ingredients needed will depend on what your learner chooses (suggested Angel Food cake: sugar, vanilla, egg whites, almond extract, salt, cream of tartar, cake flour, cake pan, oven)
- 74: Origami origami paper (usually 15x15 cm)
- 75: Memory Game one copy of Psalm 18:30 for each learner.
- 75: OR Visualize the Verse art supplies of your choice, such as colored pencils, markers, and/or paint
- 79: Clean Pennies 20 dull, dirty pennies, white vinegar, salt, clear, shallow bowl (not metal), 2 clean steel nails, clean steel screw, paper towels
- 82: Cheer box chocolate, an encouraging book, candle, succulent, lotion, etc.
- 82: AND/OR Handmade Card Card stock, watercolors, paint brushes, stickers, stamps and ink
- 83: Mailing cards cards from Day 82, stamps
- 85: Meal of Condolence hard boiled eggs, lentils, bread/bagels
- 86: *Broken Glass Art* shattered/broken glass (you can purchase glassware in different colors at a thrift store don't break anything precious!), <u>modge podge</u> or other strong, clear glue, a canvas, large flat tile, or other background for your art, gloves to protect your hands
- 88: Keyword Study a copy of Psalm 78 (or mark in your Bibles if you prefer), highlighters
- 88: OR Monument building supplies of your choice, such as Legos, blocks, Minecraft, etc.
- 91: Memory Verse Legos, a Sharpie or marker
- 92: *Keyword Study* a copy of Psalm 86 (or highlight/draw in your Bible if you prefer), highlighters, colored pencils
- 93: *Neighborhood Prayer* a screenshot of a satellite image of your neighborhood (or the neighborhood of your church or school), printed or digital such as Google Earth
- 103: Mirror Reminder whiteboard markers, a bathroom mirror or window in your home or school
- 105: *Prayer Poster* wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape
- 106: Foundation Experiment Two Styrofoam houses, scoop of sand, piece of ceramic tile, two glass cake pans, two glass jars (one filled with water and one filled with acetone / 18-20 oz. each), spray bottle with water (rain)
- 107: Map of Ascent a copy of map number 36 (Israel During the Time of Jesus) from this link
- 108: Kingdom Praise Legos are an optional add-on for today's project
- 111: *Mason Jar Luminary* glass mason jars of any size, acrylic paint in any color, paintbrush, black vinyl or black paint, tea lights (battery or wax)
- 113: *Prayer Poster* wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape
- 115: Daniel Fast (meal) choose <u>a recipe</u> or go with <u>Healthy Fried Rice</u> (cooked brown rice, olive oil, asparagus, bell pepper, scallions, garlic, ginger, liquid aminos, rice vinegar, sesame oil, hot sauce, skillet, knife and cutting board, stove top)
- 117: *Praise and Campfire* supplies for a campfire including wood, kindling, matches, and a safe spot for a fire; chairs; instruments if you want to do worship with music, and s'mores ingredients and sticks (optional but fun)
- 122: Praying for Refugees a copy of World Vision's Refugee Prayer Guide and a world map you can write on
- 124: Obstacle Course outdoor or large open space, cones or chairs to weave around, jump rope, balls, pool noodles scrap lumber... exact items needed will vary
- 130: Feast ingredients and supplies to host some friends for a meal; specific items needed will vary. Choose



a treat or meal that your guests will love!

- 131: *Memory Verse* a puzzle you don't mind writing on the back of (~48 pieces is ideal) or <u>a blank puzzle</u> to write on
- 133: *Prayer Poster* wall-sized poster or large sheet of paper (at least 3x3 feet you can also tape printer paper together), markers, wall-safe tape
- 134: Habakkuk Verse Shirt White t-shirt, fabric paint
- 138: Solomon's Bride art supplies of your choice, such as colored pencils, markers, paint, etc.
- 143: Partner Workout a medicine ball (really any kick ball or basketball-sized object will do), floor or yoga mat (optional)
- 144: *Mason Jar Reminder* glass mason jars of any size, acrylic paint in any color, paintbrush, black vinyl or black paint, pea gravel, potting soil, and a plant
